



Shire President's Message

I recently attended the Australian Council of Local Government (ACLG) Plenary Meeting, a forum for the Australian Government and local government,



at Parliament House, Canberra. The theme was "Building Resilience in Local Communities".

I found the extended breakout session for rural inland councils to be most valuable. Shire Presidents, Ministers and parliamentary secretaries shared ideas, practices and policies about how we can work together to strengthen our communities and have input into federal policy making. Our session, with Hon Tony Burke MP (Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry) and Hon Penny Wong (Minister for Climate Change and Water), focused on water trading issues and the recent Victorian fires. Outcomes and decisions from resulting government policy will ultimately flow on to affect us in the west.

The Prime Minister used the ACLG meeting to announce additional funding of \$220 million for the Community Infrastructure Program in 2009-10. The Shire of Manjimup will receive \$132,000 towards community infrastructure. Council will be seeking suggestions from the community on how these funds be best applied, later in the year.

All in all, the meeting was very worthwhile.

Hon Donna Faragher, Minister for Environment, launched the Walpole-Nornalup Inlets Marine Park Management Plan and a management plan for the Walpole Wilderness area in Walpole last week.

The marine park encompasses the 100-hectare Walpole Inlet, the 1,300-hectare Nornalup Inlet and the tidal reaches of the Frankland, Deep and Walpole rivers and is zoned for recreation which allows for recreational fishing to occur in all areas.

The Minister also visited the Donnelly River settlement with DEC and Shire representatives on Friday.
