The long weekend in June attracted a large number of visitors to the Shire for the Manjimup 15,000 motocross and the Manjimup Truffle Affaire, providing our own "economic stimulus". Both events were effectively promoted and lived up to expectations, receiving great national coverage post-event in the media. Congratulations to all concerned.

In 1980 a small band of enthusiastic members of the Manjimup Motor Cycle Club had the vision to launch an international motocross event with \$15,000 prize money. The commitment of the members and friends donating time and equipment saw huge improvements to the infrastructure and captured the attention of international riders. This placed the MMCC and the Cosy Creek Circuit firmly on the international motocross map. It's a fantastic success story which has seen the event run over three decades, benefitting the Shire economically and strategically.

In a first this year MMCC leased the entire licensed motocross facility to promoter Willie Thomson. The weekend saw members and volunteers from different organizations assisting to make the event a success. I sincerely hope that the Manjimup 15,000 returns to the same level as in its heyday.

Mitchell's Livestock Transport experienced a cattle truck rollover on 9 Feb 2009 on a section of the Pemberton Northcliffe Road which comes under State jurisdiction. The incident was particularly distressing for all who attended. Mitchells have generously donated a total of \$1,500 to the FESA Pemberton, Manjimup Junior Basketball Association, Manjimup Marlin Swimming Club, Pemberton Junior Netball Association and Southerners Junior Football Club. The company expresses its thanks to the fire brigade and the community overall for its understanding and assistance.
