COUNCIL UPDATES

Royalties for Regions
The Shire of Manjimup has been allocated \$1.5m for this financial year through the State Government's Royalties for Regions program. Council will be asked to allocate the funding at this week's meeting on Thu 22 Jan 2009.

Storm Damage
Major storm damage occurred on Sat 20 Dec 2008 to an area west of Wheatley Coast Road and South West Highway. Strong winds brought down trees and power lines with major flooding in and around Northcliffe, with the majority of flood damage to Windy Harbour Road, Parkfield Drive, Datchet Road, Richardson Road, Tattenham Road and Double Bridges Roads. Trees were removed from most roads in the Pemberton district with the worst damage experienced along Golf Links Road and Pemberton North Road. They were however removed from as far as Mitcheldean Road north of Manjimup
