Shire President's Message

Manjimup SuperTown = Super Opportunity

Last week Minister Grylls announced Manjimup as one of nine towns selected to be a SuperTown. The other South West SuperTowns selected were Margaret River and Collie.

What does this mean for us? Firstly, it symbolises the State Government's confidence in Manjimup's future and Manjimup's role as regional service centre and its importance in food security for the State. This confidence is backed by funding to undertake SuperTown growth planning (potential doubling of the population) and access to significant funding for critical projects. It also means State Government agencies have been instructed to support Manjimup towards this outcome which has already been reflected by additional funding towards upgrading the Warren District Hospital. This confidence, planning and investments is normally a catalyst for the private sector to recognise and respond to the Government's strategy. Secondly, community participation will be critical to the process through a community reference group. This group can build on the visioning work already underway through the Manjimup Futures work. There will be a series of formal announcements, public notices and community meetings to follow where more details will be provided.
