## Statutory Services

### Building Services

With the recent approval of Royalties for Regions (R4R) funding, the following projects will commence shortly: a chemical dump point for caravans and campers located in Pioneer Park, Walpole, improvements to the acoustic performance of the ceiling in the Council Chambers, Permanent sign poles at the entry points to each town within the Shire to display event signage, installation of an alternative power supply connection to the Manjimup Town Hall and Administration Building, and upgrade to the Administration Centre & Town Hall entrance, steps & ramps.

### Planning and Sustainability

Advertising of the draft West Northcliffe Structure plan closed on 31 May with a total of 13 submissions being received. The submissions will be reviewed by Shire staff and tabled for Council consideration at a later meeting.

There are several applications before Council this week for the creation of an additional 218 rural residential lots across the Shire.

### Ranger & Emergency Services

A dog attack on sheep in the Dingup area is being investigated.

Animal welfare issues continue in both Manjimup and Walpole.

### Warren Blackwood Healthy Communities Initiative

The Shire of Manjimup, in partnership with the Shires of Bridgetown -Greenbushes and Nannup will receive \$703,000 over the next 2.5 years to reduce the prevalence of overweight and obesity. The Healthy Communities Initiative targets individuals not predominately in the paid workforce and at risk of developing chronic disease, by maximising the number of adults engaged in physical activity and healthy eating programs. A full time coordinator and part time support officer will be appointed by the Shire to ensure the project is successfully implemented. This is a National Partnership Agreement on Preventive Health initiative funded by the Australian Government.

### HACC

The Shire has secured an additional \$220,736 to expand HACC services and plan a Centre based Day Care facility.
