## Corporate Services

### Domestic cat laws to be introduced in WA

A recent achievement has been the introduction of new State-wide domestic cat control legislation. The *Cat Bill 2011*, which was introduced into parliament last month by the minister, requires compulsory identification, registration and sterilisation of domestic cats. It is a major step towards addressing the unwanted impacts cats

have on the community and environment, as well as improving cat welfare across the State. A phase-in period will ensure local governments and members of the public have time to prepare for the legislation's introduction with these requirements taking effect from 1 November 2011.



## Statutory Services

### Planning & Sustainability

The WAPC is currently reviewing the Residential Design Codes, seeking comment on the possibility of removing density control (i.e. lot size) from the R-Codes and place it into a separate subdivision policy and for linking setback and open space requirements to the size of a lot rather than to its density code. Comments until 31 August 2011. Details of the review can be obtained at .

## Ranger & Emergency Services

- Rangers are currently focusing on disabled parking bay compliance.
- The draft Fuel Hazard Reduction Plan is nearing completion and will be presented to Council for adoption.
- Construction of the Glenoran & Mordalup Bush Fire Brigade fire sheds is continuing.
- Straying stock has become a recent problem arising from fence damage as a result of recent weather conditions .
