Results of the Council Election 2011

The results of the West Ward Council Election held on Saturday 15 October 2011 are as follows:

Finance & Administration

- Works on the central Niche Wall at the Manjimup Cemetery started last week, after an assessment it was decided the wall should be replaced. All ashes have been removed and the new wall should be completed by the 21 October 2011 and ashes reinstated.
- An assessment of rates income over the rates period has shown 65.4% of 2011/2012 rates raised were collected by the due date. There are now 1,375 assessments on installments which is an increase of 28% on last year (being an indication that cash is tight in our local community).

Manjimup Town Hall Kitchen upgrade is progressing. The kitchen has been stripped to make way for the new fixtures and fittings. Preliminary plumbing and electrical works have also been complete.
