## Statutory Services

### Ranger & Emergency Services

♦ Good Communication is needed in times of emergencies. The Local Emergency Management Committee identified that at some emergency situations there is an inability for Police to communicate with other emergency services. To overcome this problem, the Shire of Manjimup supplied the Manjimup, Pemberton & Walpole Police with WAERN radios that communicate across a range of radio mediums.

- ♦ Inspections of sub-division road verges for the coming fire season have commenced.
- ♦ Heap and windrow burning throughout the Shire continues.
- ♦ Rangers will have an increased presence in the Pemberton and Northcliffe areas following on animal management and control issues.

- ♦ Construction of the Mordalup and Glenoran Bush Fire Shed are continuing.

### Planning & Sustainability

♦ Energy Audit - The Shire has subscribed to the Planet Footprint reporting service. This will provide us with quarterly reports on our energy use, including power, fuel and gas. The purpose of the reporting is to identify how much energy we use and convert this to the amount of CO2 we emit. Over time, we will get an accurate picture of where we use the most energy and will guide us on where to direct efforts to reduce energy use.

### Community Services

♦ The Healthy Communities Initiative - 'Well Being Warren Blackwood' was officially launched by Minister Terry Redman on Friday 26 Aug 2011. Community launches will be held in Manjimup on 27 Sept 2011 and Northcliffe on 28 Sept 2011. Walpole and Pemberton dates are yet to be confirmed.

### HACC

Community members in the Manjimup Shire are invited to a free Stay On Your Feet® Activity Day in the Manjimup Town Hall on Monday 12 September 2011 from 10am - 1pm to celebrate Stay On Your Feet® Week.

Stay On Your Feet® Activity Day addresses the Nine Steps To Stay On Your Feet®, which are positive steps people can take to reduce their risk of having a fall and will conclude with a free healthy light lunch.

The event held in Manjimup this year will be co-hosted by Well Being Warren Blackwood. This is a Healthy Community Initiative funded by the Federal Government.

### AquaCentre

#### Temporary Closure

♦ The AquaCentre will be closed for facility maintenance from Thu 22 Sept 2011 to Thu 29 Sept 2011, reopening on Fri 30 Sept 2011 at 6.00am. Freestylers Swim School participants will be credited for any classes scheduled during this time. Fitness participants and crèche facilities will not be affected.

♦ The AquaCentre has installed 25 metre lap pool blankets. The first few days are showing some great results with improved pool temperature in both pools, and a lot less humidity in the morning when the facility opens.

♦ A collection point has been established for household batteries (torch, toy, phone etc) at the Ralston Road Recycling and Refuse Centre. This service will be extended to other Council waste disposal sites.
