### Digital TV for the Shire of Manjimup

The Shire has been notified the upgrade to Digital TV will commence late 2013, with analogue TV ending transmission around late 2013 / early 2014. Manjimup & Pemberton TV towers will be upgraded to support rebroadcasting of Digital TV, however; Quinninup, Northcliffe & Walpole will not be upgraded. Subsidies will be offered to residents within these areas to upgrade to AVAST satellite TV in order to receive digital TV transmission. Subsidies will commence from October 2012 & continue through to the end of December 2013.

### Successful Grant Funding

The Shire has been successful in the following grants:

- \$25,000 - Financial Planning - Dept of Local Government.
- \$225,000 - Windy Harbour Boat Ramp - Dept of Transport.
- \$50,000 Joint funding with DEC - Walpole Boat Ramp - Dept of Transport.

### Planning and Sustainability

- The Shire has recently made a submission on the Draft State Rural Planning Policies. Whilst supportive of the objectives of the policy to protect agricultural land from inappropriate development, concerns were raised regarding the potential impact of the policies on rural residential servicing levels and the plantation timber industry.
- Draft Prostitution Bill 2011 - The Shire has been invited to comment on the WA Government's draft Prostitution Bill 2011. The Shire's previous stance of not supporting brothels in residential areas will be maintained.

- The fuel hazard reduction program for 2010/11 has been completed and pre-planning work for 2011/12 has commenced.
