**5.2 RANGERS**  
**5.2.4 Disabled Parking Bays Identification and Enforcement**

Objectives

- Provide the statutory procedure for the creation of disabled parking bays;
- Facilitate the inclusion of disabled people within the Shire of Manjimup by providing disabled parking bays that can be legally monitored and controlled for illegal usage;
- Address the strategies contained within the Strategic Plan and the Disability Access and Inclusion Plan in which both support the provision of disabled access including disabled parking bays;
- Provide a centralised register of disabled parking bays approved by Council within the Shire of Manjimup; and
- Protect the Shire of Manjimup against any potential legal claim by ensuring that disabled parking bays conform to Australian Standards where possible.

Area of Application

Applicable in the town sites of Manjimup, Pemberton, Northcliffe and Walpole only.

Policy Measures

**Procedure for creation of a disabled parking bay**

- The Local Government (Parking for Disabled Persons) Regulations 1988 apply to the designated Parking Regions established under the existing Shire of Manjimup By-Law Relating to Parking Region being the townsites of Manjimup, Pemberton, Northcliffe and Walpole;
- To create a disabled parking bay under the Local Government (Parking for Disabled Persons) Regulations 1988 within the identified Parking Region requires a simple majority resolution of Council;
- The Parking Region applies to both land under the control of the Shire of Manjimup and private land where a private land owner applies to Council and Council resolves to create a disabled parking bay on that land (a Development Approval would also suffice);
- Disabled parking bays are to be clearly identified for Council approval by providing a grid coordinate reference taken from the centre of the disabled parking bay and based on DMS & UTM Position Formats and WGS84 Datum. In addition, a generalised description of the location is to be provided for inclusion in this policy but this is not considered to be the legal description of the bay; and
- All disabled parking bays are required to be constructed in accordance with the requirement of:
  - The land on which a parking bay has been set aside shall be identified by —
    - (a) the words “Disabled Parking Only” clearly written on the ground within the limits of the parking bay; and
    - (b) an elevated sign, so located as to identify the parking bay to which it relates, on which there appears the international symbol for access for the disabled.

**Compliance with Australian Standards**

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That where practicable, the Shire of Manjimup will use its best endeavours to conform to Australian Standards when constructing or maintaining new or existing disabled parking bays.

Applicable Australian Standards requiring consideration include:

- AS2890.5-1993 Parking facilities – on street parking;
- AS2890.1-2004 Parking facilities – off street parking;
- AS1428.1-2001 Design for access and mobility; and
- AS1742.11-1999 Manual of uniform traffic control devices – parking controls.

**Enforcement**

Shire Rangers shall only enforce disabled parking bays where they are in compliance with this policy.
