This year we will see the following major projects - Pemberton • Colocation building construction, air conditioner upgrade at the AquaCentre, Pioneer Park Walpole toilet upgrade, a new toilet block near the Pemberton Mill Hall, preparation for the redevelopment of the Rea Park and Collier Street Reserve, pathways and furniture at Quinninup dam, and major bridge • Statutory and strategic planning - development approval, land works on Mordalup Road. We are bringing free wi-fi to Pemberton, Northcliffe and Walpole CBD's, upgrades to the

Northcliffe basketball courts and a pathway to Clem Collins Stadium. There are many tremendous amount of work that goes into the normal operations of a local government.
