Council Meeting

The next Ordinary Meeting of the Manjimup Shire Council will be held at the Pemberton Sports Club, Club Road, Pemberton.

The meeting commences at 5.30pm on Thursday, 13 June 2019.

Any person wishing to address or ask a question of the Council is welcome to do so at the start of the meeting. Please note that if there are confidential items to be discussed, members of the public may be asked to leave the room for a period of time.

Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation

Graphite/Perup Roads realignment

The highway works are all complete, except for the installation of a small section of footpath on Graphite Road, landscaping and some very minor clean up works.

Manjimup Heritage Park

The State Timber Museum was recently named a level 3 winner in the Australian Museums and Galleries Association Awards, Permanent Exhibition or Gallery Fitout Category, at the AMA GA National Conference in Alice Springs.

Brockman Street transformation

Delivery of the roofing material is expected in approximately six weeks time. The material is a flat polycarbonate sheeting product called "Danpalon" and has an appearance very similar to glass.

Roof installation

A request for quote to install the roofing material has been completed, with several submissions received. Karamfiles Builders has been awarded the contract, representing best value for money for the Shire. Installation will take approximately 15 days of favourable weather to complete. Further information regarding the installation and any impact on the local road network or footpaths will be provided in due course.

Balance of Civil Works

A detailed request for quote process has been completed, with the balance of the works now awarded to TRACC Civil under WALGA preferred supplier arrangements. TRACC Civil recently completed the replacement of the water main in Brockman Street and will now be completing all remaining civil works within the street including, but not limited to, the installation of new drainage infrastructure, kerbing, road surface and exposed aggregate footpaths.

This work has commenced this week and it is anticipated that it will be completed within 6-8 weeks.

As specified within the request for quote documentation, TRACC Civil are required to complete the required works with the intention of minimising impact on business in Brockman Street as much as possible, however, there will be times where road closures will simply be unavoidable. Further details regarding the potential closures are currently being finalised with TRACC Civil. Confirmation of the proposed closures will be provided as soon as possible.

Following completion of the works by TRACC Civil, electrical works; including lighting, landscaping and furniture installation will be finalised.

The full logo design brief, which is prescriptive yet uncomplicated is available from our website www.manjimup.wa.gov.au/trailbikehub.


