A lot was achieved in 2018 with some of the Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation Components being completed along with major projects in other towns including the drainage study and the resealing of Guppy Street and Hospital Avenue in Pemberton, the resealing of Middleton Road, the new playground at the Walpole Recreation Centre and the commencement of the Pioneer Park redevelopment, all the while maintaining 'business as usual' across the entire Shire.
