The Queen's Baton Relay

The Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games Queen's Baton Relay will be travelling through our Shire on Thursday 22 February 2018, having chosen Manjimup as one of the host communities. Twelve community representatives will have the honour of relaying the Baton from the Manjimup Indoor Stadium to the celebration site at the Manjimup Timber and Heritage Park.

The Queen's Baton Relay started on Commonwealth Day, Monday 13 March 2017, at Buckingham Palace when Her Majesty the Queen placed her message inside of the Baton.
