Why have the parking bays been changed in Nockolds Street?

The 90 degree parking bays along Nockolds Street are constructed to Australian Standards of 5.4m long but widened to 2.8m wide to allow for maneuverability. Crossing of the white line to enter parking bays is a result of the narrow and less than standard traffic aisles due to the constraints of the distance between the north and south kerbs which allows for two-way traffic along Nockolds Street.
