North Walpole Road construction is complete. Approximately 1km of road has been upgraded with a 6m wide seal as part of an ongoing Regional Road Group and Shire project.

Design for Walpole Main Street, stage 2 is almost complete. Waiting on Main Roads Great Southern for design approval.

Works for Walpole Family Centre carpark have commenced with the removal of a large peppermint tree to facilitate more parking bays.

The Property Care Team completed the pouring of the new concrete pads in Pioneer Park, in preparation to install the new bin surrounds.
