On Saturday the opening of the Manjin Rec Plaza will coincide with the youth festival and the day will be packed with activities for children of all ages.

Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation

Component 1

• Construction of the new roundabout at the intersection of South Western Highway and Blechynden Street continues. The works are expected to be completed in May or June 2018. Although the Highway is not closed to traffic motorists should expect some delays with temporary traffic signals in place.

• The realignment of Graphite and Perup Roads has been approved by Main Roads WA.

Component 3

• Manjin Recreation Plaza continues to be a popular meeting place and is always abuzz with activity after school and on weekends. An official opening is set for 21 April 2018.

Wellness & Respite Community Centre

• The Wellness and Respite Community Centre is nearing completion and the Home and Community Care team are gearing up to move into the new premises during this month. The construction of the wellness centre has created substantial employment opportunities averaging eight local employees on site throughout the course of construction. There will be ongoing positions for 30 employees including support workers, home maintenance staff, administration, gardener, 30 volunteers and six more employees to be appointed shortly including registered and enrolled nurses and respite staff.

Annual Hard Waste Collection
May 2018

The Shire of Manjimup is providing a hard waste collection in 2018. **This is a free service.**

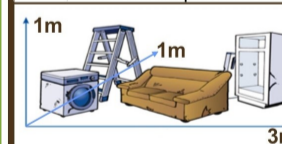
- ♦ This service is only available to **domestic properties** which have an existing regular kerbside bin collection service.
- ♦ Hard waste is defined as furniture and other household goods.
- ♦ Please have your items out at least **one week before the collection date** in a place on your verge that will not be a danger or an inconvenience to others.
- ♦ Items longer than 2m will not be collected.
- ♦ Maximum 3 cubic metres (1m x 1m x 3m) collected per property.

The service **will** collect:

- furniture and mattresses
- air-conditioners
- televisions and stereos
- refrigerators & freezers with doors removed
- other whitegoods
- general hard waste such as carpet and lino

The service **will not** collect:

- general domestic waste
- gas cylinders, hazardous materials (asbestos, poisons)
- greenwaste
- liquid waste (oils, paints)
- building materials
- pallets or shopping trolleys
- vehicle batteries or tyres



PLEASE DO NOT put items out after collection dates as they will not be collected and litter fines may apply.

Properties with more than 3 cubic metres will have to make private arrangements to have waste removed.
