### Manjin Rec Plaza

•Sadly due to unfavourable weather forecast for Saturday 21 April the official opening of the Manjin Recreation Plaza was cancelled. It is expected to be rescheduled for spring.

# Wellness & Respite Community Centre

•The Wellness and Respite Community Centre is very close to completion and the Home and Community Care team have moved in. The construction of the wellness centre has created substantial employment opportunities averaging eight local employees on site throughout the course of construction. There will be ongoing positions for 30 employees including support workers, home maintenance staff, administration, gardener, 30 volunteers and six more employees to be appointed shortly including registered and enrolled nurses and respite staff.

### **Manjimup Timber and Heritage Park**

• The Hon Adele Farina visited the park on Friday an officially opened the Volunteer Community Hub, the accessible pathways in the hamlet and the Sandra Donovan Sound Shell.

•The Forge has been completed in the Blacksmith Shop and wiring has been carried out, waiting on fittings.

90% of graphics for the State Timber Museum redevelopment have been completed and approved, pre-wiring complete, memorial area gutted with new structural steel installed and external boards washed down.

The locomotive and williamette have been sandblasted and painted. Further design works for the area are being undertaken.



The Shire of Manjimup is providing a hard waste collection in 2018. This is a free service.

- This service is only available to domestic properties which have an existing regular kerbside bin collection service. Hard waste is defined as furniture and other household goods.
- Please have your items out at least one week before the collection date in a place on your verge that will not be a danger or an inconvenience to others.
- Items longer than 2m will not be collected.
- Maximum 3 cubic metres (1m x 1m x 3m) collected per property





such as carpet and lino x vehicle batteries or tyres PLEASE DO NOT put items out after collection dates as they will not be collected and litter fines may apply.

Properties with more than 3 cubic metres will have to make private 3m arrangements to have waste removed.
