Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation Component 1

• Construction of the new roundabout at the intersection of South Western Highway and Blechynden Street commenced on 19 February, the works are expected to be completed in June 2018. Although the Highway will not be closed to traffic motorists should expect some delays with temporary traffic signals in place.



•The realignment of Graphite and Perup Roads has been approved by Main Roads WA.



Component 2

 The locomotive and steam hauler have been relocated to their new position on the disused section of rail adjacent to the South Western Highway. Scaffolding has been erected in preparation for the refurbishment which will occur shortly.

Component 3

 Manjin Recreation Plaza is being well used by locals and visitors. An official opening will be held on 21 April 2018.

Component 4

 Tender for construction of improvements to Allambie Park will be called for mid-year.



Component 5

 The Shire is reviewing the first draft of marketing company PPR's presentation.

Component 6

•The poplar trees have been cut down in Coronation Park, fencing will remain until the stumps are removed in the near future.

Component 7

•The new southern arch tribute which was chosen and voted on by the community was installed in February and some landscaping is taking place.
