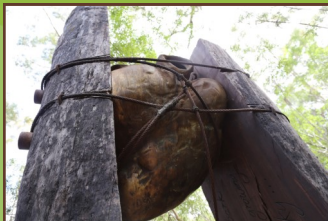

Plans are well underway for the ceremony and an action packed afternoon and evening in the Timber Park. Twelve community representatives will have the honour of relaying the Baton from the Manjimup Indoor Stadium to the celebration site at the Manjimup Timber and Heritage Park.

The Queen's Baton Relay started on Commonwealth Day, Monday 13 March 2017, at Buckingham Palace when Her Majesty the Queen placed her message inside of the Baton.

Prohibited Burning Period

We are currently in the prohibited period in both Zone 8 (Manjimup, Pemberton & Quinninup) and Zone 6 (Northcliffe, Walpole).

Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation

Component 1

- Construction of the new roundabout at the intersection of South Western Highway and Blechynden Street will commence on 19 February with expected completion in May 2018.
- The realignment of Graphite and Perup Roads has been approved by Main Roads WA.

Component 2

- The Sandra Donovan Sound Shell is nearing completion and will be used for the Commonwealth Games Queen's Baton Relay and Act Belong Commit evening in the park on 22 February 2018.
- Refurbishment of the State Timber Museum will commence shortly and the development of the content is in progress.
- Finalised design documentation is being prepared by Holton Connor Architects for the South West Energy Experience (SWEE) building. Creative Spaces have been awarded the contract for exhibition design and fit-out.
- Final designs for the new signage and interpretation guides throughout the park are being prepared.
- A request for quote is being prepared for civil design around the SWEE building and new car park area.
- Planning is underway for a new disabled access picnic area north of the slide.
- Two new access ramps have been installed in the Historic Hamlet with handrails to be fitted soon.
- Earthworks on the new display area for the Rail Relics is almost complete.
- The Wellness and Respite Community Centre is approximately 78% complete with an expected practical completion date in mid April.
- Volunteer hub handover complete, some minor finishing touches required.
- Cladding and oiling of boards on the agricultural exhibit to be complete this week.
- Replica Blacksmith Shop windows installed, electrical work and forge to be completed within two weeks.

Component 3

- Arc Infrastructure have removed the rail between Ipsen and Ralston Streets.
- Opening of the realSpaces outdoor Gym occurred on Tuesday 23 January 2018.
- Manjin Recreation Plaza is progressing well, expect an official opening in April 2018.
- The train playground equipment has been relocated and refurbished, some soft fall to be installed prior to opening.
- The middle tier between the outdoor gym and the train playground will be fitted out with a BBQ, picnic table.

Component 4

- Tender for construction of Allambie Park to be called for mid-year.

Component 5

- Marketing company PPR visited Manjimup and conducted filming and interviews over the Cherry Festival Weekend. They are currently working on the prospectus.

Component 6

- Installation of remaining new rubbish bins and street furniture continues.
- Poplar trees in the southern section of Coronation Park have been ringbarked and poisoned in preparation for removal.

Component 7

- Southern arch tribute installation expected 8 February 2018.
- Landscaping and tree planting along Mottram Street and the South Western Highway continues.
