Local Government Elections

An ordinary postal election will be held on the 19 October 2019 to fill five vacancies on Council. There are five candidates contending to fill one vacancy in the west ward, and seven candidates to fill three vacancies in the central ward.

Congratulations to Councillor Kim Skoss who was re-elected unopposed in the North Ward.

I encourage you to review the candidate profiles on the Shire website and contact the candidates with any queries you have, to enable you make an informed decision on who will be representing you on Council.

Those elected will hold their position on Council for four years.

Fire Season

As the weather begins to warm it is now time to start preparing your home and property for bushfire season ahead of the restricted burning period commencing in November. The firebreak notice will be arriving in your letter box soon and contains important information on the requirements for your property.

The penalty for non-compliance with the firebreak notice is \$5,000.

You are reminded that fuel hazard reduction burning is not an opportunity to burn rubber, plastic, furniture, and household rubbish.

Post your vote early. Completed postal voting packages must reach the Returning Officer by 6.00pm on election day, Saturday 19 October 2019.

You may hand deliver your package to an electoral officer at the Shire of Manjimup during business hours before election day or at the polling place between 8.00am and 6.00pm on election day.

Timed Parking - Manjimup CBD

Following the recent finalisation of new Parking Local Laws, the Shire of Manjimup is proposing the introduction of timed parking zones within the Manjimup Town Centre.

The intent behind introduced timed parking is to ensure that the availability of parking bays in high turnover locations is maximised.

Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation

Manjimup Heritage Park Revitalisation Project

Fit out of Agricultural Shed and Blacksmith Shop continuing.

PowerUp Electricity Museum internal fit out has commenced, fit out of the café will commence soon and the Visitor Centre is working with Shire staff on design ideas.

TRACC Civil have commenced the major landscaping around the building.

We are working with Armsign on signage and way finding for the park and the extended Linear Path network and connections.

Accommodation Site

Following an expression of interest period, a proposal to advertise for the disposal of the property will go before Council at the next meeting.

Brockman Street Transformation

The civil works have been completed, with the red exposed aggregate footpath and contrasting applied to the alfresco and other non-footpath areas looking great, complemented by the new red asphalt road and parking areas.

Landscaping of the garden beds, including the mature trees also looking great.

Installation of the roofing material will commence when the product is recertified under the new Australian Standards introduced on 1 May 2019 and the consequent changes to the National Construction Code.
