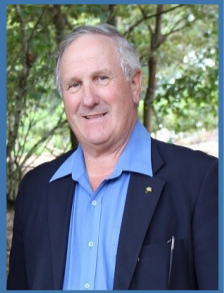

Council Meeting

The next Ordinary Meeting of the Manjimup Shire Council will be held in the Council Chambers, Cnr Rose and Brockman Streets, Manjimup. The meeting commences at 5.30pm on Thursday, 28 February 2019. Any person wishing to address or ask a question of the Council is welcome to do so at the start of the meeting. Please note that if there are confidential items to be discussed, members of the public may be asked to leave the room for a period of time.

Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation South West Energy Experience

Several larger pieces of machinery were placed on the slab earlier this month. These pieces are too large to bring into the building without cranes. The building will now be constructed around these pieces.

Currently we are working toward a construction completion date of September 2019 however the overall project is due to be complete and opened in December 2019. Following construction we will be fitting out the exhibition, café and visitor centre and doing extensive landscaping around the building.

Graphite/Perup Roads realignment

Expected completion in May 2019.

Contractor TRACC Civil are making good progress on the construction, we can expect to see some asphalt laid in March 2019.

Landscaping will be occurring between the Visitor Centre and Ipsen Street.

Pram ramps connecting to linear path will be installed soon.

Brockman Street transformation

Karamfiles Builders have been appointed for the construction of the three section roof over Brockman Street from Giblett Street to Rose Street.
