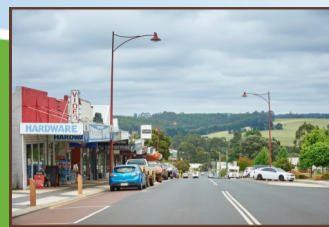




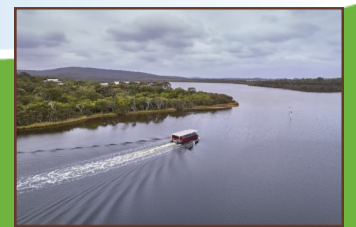

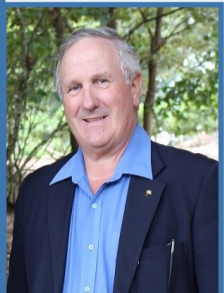

Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation

We are into the final year of the Town Centre Revitalisation Project. We have undergone some amazing transformations throughout the project and the benefits are definitely showing in tourism and economic growth for the region.

South West Energy Experience

Expected completion in December 2019.

- Builder Civilcon commenced site works in October 2018.
- Works are progressing well with the concrete slab poured on Friday 25 January 2019.

Graphite/Perup Roads realignment

Expected completion in May 2019.

Contractor TRACC Civil are making good progress on the construction, we can expect to see some asphalt laid in March 2019.



Brockman Street transformation

Karamfiles Builders have been appointed for the construction of the three section roof over Brockman Street from Giblett Street to Rose Street.

Surveyors have spot marked centre post locations and the required kerbing has been removed. Works on the footings have commenced.

Removal of the old toilet block behind the Community Information Office will occur soon to make way for a public parking area.

Linear Park

Surveyors have been marking out the rear Woolworths carpark extension and the connection from Johnson Crescent.

Landscaping will be occurring between the Visitor Centre and Ipsen Street.

Pram ramps connecting to linear path will be installed soon.
