Fire Season

We are now in restricted burning period for both zones.

The requirements of the firebreak notice 2021/2022 need to be in place by 11 December 2021 in Zone 8 - Manjimup, Pemberton and Quinninup and 18 December 2021 in Zone 6 - Northcliffe and Walpole. Rangers will commence inspections on the 12 and 19 of December 2021.

The penalty for non-compliance with the firebreak notice is \$5,000.

Timber Industry Transition

2022 is going to bring about challenges in light of the State Government's recent decision to end the native forest industry and Council will be working with our communities and stakeholders to ensure the best outcome for our region.

The CEO, Deputy Shire President and I recently hosted the Premier Mark McGowan and MLA Jane Kelsbie for a discussion on the Native Forestry Industry Just Transition Plan, including potential projects within the Warren Blackwood Alliance of Councils regions and the transition fund. The meeting was positive and has forged a relationship and dialogue with the State Government going forward.
