Wildcards Exhibition

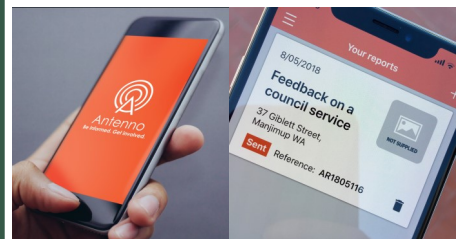

Commencing from the 18 June the Northcliffe Library will be co-locating with the Visitor Centre. It is expected that the move will be complete by 1 July 2018. The move will see the library opening hours increase from 15 to 49 hours per week.

Visitor centre and library staff are undertaking training to ensure a smooth transition for customers.

**Manjimup Town Centre Revitalisation
Wellness & Respite Community Centre**

The Wellness and Respite Community Centre was officially opened by Mr Rick Wilson MP on Friday 18 May 2018.

The Community Home Care team are now located at the new building.

The new centre will:

- ensure clients (particularly those with dementia) are in a safe, stimulating and supervised environment;
- incorporate the Shire of Manjimup Home Community Care office;
- provide a one-stop shop for clients for information about aged & disability support.

Services to be offered at the centre will include:

- social and recreational facilities;
- respite and support for carers;
- support with exercise and nutrition;
- stay on your Feet program;
- access to relevant knowledge and information.

The centre will house:

- an information and assistance kiosk (shop front/reception);
- multipurpose conference/meeting/function space, with commercial kitchen for hire;
- office accommodation;
- respite care unit including an 8 bed respite wing and dementia support capacity.

The grounds will be landscaped to incorporate sensory gardens and comfortable leisure space interconnected to the adjoining Manjimup Heritage Park, Public Library, Art Gallery, proposed hotel accommodation; proposed Manjimup Seniors Affordable Housing Project and the central business district.
