You are urged to read the notice through and be sure you are taking the right precautions for your land category. Make a note of the phone number of your Fire Control Officer.

The requirements of the notice are to be in place by the 11 December 2018 in Zone 8 (Manjimup/Pemberton/

Quinninup) and 18 December 2018 in Zone 6 (Northcliffe/ Walpole).

The penalty for non-compliance with the notice is \$5,000.
