Fire Season

The regulated burning period for Zone 6 - Northcliffe and Walpole commences on the 19 November 2019.

If you haven't prepared your home and property for bushfire season and made your plan you need to do so now. The firebreak notice 2019/2020 should have arrived in your letter box and contains important information on the requirements for your property.

The penalty for non-compliance with the firebreak notice is \$5,000.

You are reminded that fuel hazard reduction burning is not an opportunity to burn rubber, plastic, furniture, and household rubbish.

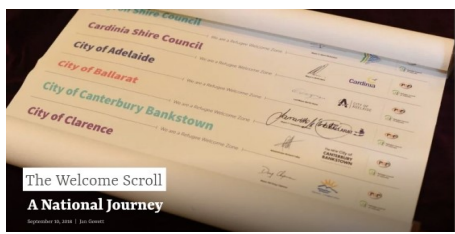
