Re-elected West Ward Councillor Murray Ventris officially opened the new Little Taddies Day Care Centre in Pemberton on Tuesday 19 October 2021, following their substantial renovation. It was an honour to have been invited to the opening as I opened the original Little Taddies in 2003.

The newly refurbished Little Taddies Day Care Centre in Pemberton was officially opened by West Ward Councillor elect Murray Ventris on Tuesday 19 October 2021.

The centre has been substantially refurbished as part of the Pemberton Community Colocation Precinct project.

The WA Government, through Lotterywest, provided a grant of almost \$1.2 million to support the precinct.

Little Taddies Child Care Centre, an important service for the Pemberton community, has received significant upgrades to provide a safe, inclusive and modern facility for educators and children alike. The refurbishment, which commenced in February 2021 has been undertaken by Bunbury based builder, Civilcon. The project included removal and replacement of redundant, unsafe and aged infrastructure, upgrades to make the whole facility fully accessible, and improvements to create a more functional and comfortable space. All upgrades complemented the excellent work the centre has already contributed to the site including a great outdoor play area. These refurbishments will substantially enhance the development and educational opportunities for the children attending.
