Fire Season

The regulated burning period for Zone 8 -Maniimup. Pemberton and Quinninup commences on the 9 November 2021 and on 19 November 2021 in Zone 6 - Northcliffe and Walpole.

If you haven't prepared your home and property for bushfire season and made your

firebreak notice 2021/2022 should have arrived in your letter box and contains important information on the requirements for your property.

The penalty for non-compliance with the firebreak notice is \$5,000.

You are reminded that fuel hazard reduction burning is not an opportunity to burn rubber, plastic, furniture, and household rubbish.

Little Taddies Child Care Centre, an important service for the Pemberton community, has received significant upgrades to provide a safe, inclusive facility for educators and children The refurbishment, which commenced in February 2021 has been undertaken by Bunbury based builder, Civilcon. The project included removal and replacement of redundant, unsafe and aged infrastructure, upgrades make the whole facility fully accessible. improvements to create a more functional and comfortable space. All upgrades complemented the excellent work the centre has already contributed to the site including a great outdoor play area. These refurbishments will substantially enhance the development and educational opportunities for the children attending.


