The all new and exciting Manjin Rec Plaza is very close to completion and will be open by the time this goes to print, stay tuned for information on the official opening in April 2018.

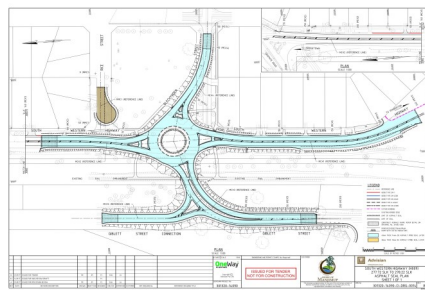
As the basketball and cricket seasons draw to a close we look forward to the commencement of the 2018 football season.

Manjimup's new entrance

Works on the new northern roundabout and modifications to the northern end of Giblett Street commenced on Monday 19 February 2018. The roundabout will change the northern façade of the Shire and is expected to encourage traffic into the Manjimup CBD. TRACC Civil have been awarded the contract and are expected to be onsite until late May or June 2018. A site office has been set up on Apex Park and some traffic delays are to be expected.
