Camp Schools

Along with the CEO and several community members, I attended a protest rally in Bunbury on Friday 20 April 2018 to support the move to keep our camp schools open. The Pemberton Camp School has been part of the culture of Pemberton for generations providing unique educational experiences for young students in the natural environment which will never be replaced. The Shire intends to do everything within its power to reverse the decision to close the camp school.

Rural Fire Service Announcement

In April the State Government announced its intention to create a Rural Fire Service. While this move gives recognition to our volunteers it is primarily a structural change within DFES and will have little effect on our Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades, where the structure will continue to be managed by the Shire. The primary role of the Rural Fire Service will be preparation and mitigation. The expected increase in emergency services levies should see an increase in prescribed burning and will help local governments manage bushfire risks. We welcome the appointment of Murray Carter as Executive Director, Murray has extensive experience in the Pemberton region with Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions and with the Premiers Department.

Official Openings

April saw the official opening of the Sandra Donovan Sound Shell in the Manjimup Timber and Heritage Park. This project is a major component of the Town Centre Revitalisation Project in Manjimup funded by Royalties for Regions and Lotterywest grant monies provided specifically for projects in the Manjimup town site. The opening of the sound shell was well attended on Friday evening 20 April and certainly showcased some of the very talented locals we have in our region and the capabilities of the sound shell as a fantastic outdoor entertainment venue.

Annual Hard Waste Collection May 2018

The Shire of Manjimup is providing a hard waste collection in 2018. This is a free service.

- This service is only available to **domestic properties** which have an existing regular kerbside bin collection service.
- Hard waste is defined as furniture and other household goods.
- Please have your items out at least **one week before the collection date** in a place on your verge that will not be a danger or an inconvenience to others.
- Items longer than 2m will not be collected.
- Maximum 3 cubic metres (1m x 1m x 3m) collected per property.
