**Fire Season**

The regulated burning period for Zone 8 - Manjimup, Pemberton and Quininnup commences on the 9 November 2019. If you haven't prepared your home and property for bushfire season and made your plan you need to do so now. The firebreak notice 2019/2020 should have arrived in your letter box and contains important information on the requirements for your property. The penalty for non-compliance with the firebreak notice is \$5,000. You are reminded that fuel hazard reduction burning is not an opportunity to burn rubber, plastic, furniture, and household rubbish.

Early in October I was honoured to be asked by Dale Atkins to officially re-open the Quininnup Tavern after a two year absence to rebuild following a devastating fire that destroyed the building in July 2017.
