Little Taddies Child Care Centre, an important service for the Pemberton community, has received significant upgrades to provide a safe, inclusive and modern facility for educators and children alike.

The refurbishment, which commenced in February 2021 has been undertaken by Bunbury based builder, Civilcon. The project included removal and replacement of redundant, unsafe and aged infrastructure, upgrades to make the whole facility fully accessible, and improvements to create a more functional and comfortable space. All upgrades complemented the excellent work the centre has already contributed to the site including a great outdoor play area. These refurbishments will substantially enhance the development and educational opportunities for the children attending.
