Fire Season

The regulated burning period for Zone 8 - Manjimup, Pemberton and Quininnup commences on the 9 November 2021 and on 19 November 2021 in Zone 6 - Northcliffe and Walpole.

If you haven't prepared your home and property for bushfire season and made your bushfire plan you need to do so now.

The firebreak notice 2021/2022 should have arrived in your letter box and contains important information on the requirements for your property.

The penalty for non-compliance with the firebreak notice is \$5,000.

You are reminded that fuel hazard reduction burning is not an opportunity to burn rubber, plastic, furniture, and household rubbish.
