10. WORKS AND SERVICES 10.1 WORKS

10.1.2 Mersea, Wilgarup and Corbalup Roads

Background & Issues

A long standing agreement exists between the Shire of Manjimup and the Shire of Bridgetown Greenbushes to assist each organisation's operations by undertaking maintenance grading of roads that fall within the adjacent Shire area.

Objectives

To reduce the overall cost to the two Shire's communities of maintaining Mersea, Wilgarup and Corbalup Roads.

Area of Application

Sections of Mersea Road, Wilgarup Road and Corbalup Road.

Policy Measures

- 1. Road grading and minor maintenance of Mersea Road, Wilgarup Road and Corbalup Road will be undertaken as follows:
 - Mersea Road: Shire of Bridgetown-Greenbushes;
 - Wilgarup Road: Shire of Manjimup from South West Highway east to the rail corridor;
 - Corbalup Road: Shire of Bridgetown-Greenbushes to Telephone Track.

2. Capital works:

Where it is proposed to upgrade these roads, and they service another Shire, a cost sharing arrangement will be negotiated between the two Shires.

Administration

Responsibility for implementing this policy shall rest with the Director Works and Services.
