# 10.1.9 School Assistance by Council's Works and Services Directorate

# Background & Issues

Schools generate significant levels of both pedestrian and vehicular traffic over short periods of time in the morning and afternoon before and after school which has the potential for creating traffic safety issues. Most schools in the district do not have sufficient well designed off-road parking facilities to adequately deal with these traffic flows and rely on the use of the road reserve to provide parking and drop-off zones. These need to be designed and constructed to provide for the safety of both pedestrians and vehicular traffic. A partnership between the school and Shire provides benefit to both parties as well as to the wider community.

#### **Objectives**

For the welfare and benefit of the wider community Council through this policy contributes towards approved traffic safety measures requested by local schools on an equal share basis. This contribution is further extended by the provision of other minor assistance using Works and Services plant and material resources.

#### **Area of Application**

Any school within the Shire of Manjimup.

#### Policy Measures

- 1. The Director Works and Services may approve and arrange for any school in the Shire assistance as necessary for traffic safety on a 50:50 contributory arrangement.
- 2. The Director Works and Services may approve in each financial year the following assistance for any school in the Shire:
  - a) Six (6) cubic metres of sand, gravel or fill; and
  - b) Road Plant for one (1) hour on site.

## Administration

The administration of this policy will be by Works.
