### Certificate II

Qualification in Rural Operations/Agriculture

Completed as coursework or school based traineeship (VET in Schools)

Subjects include: Occupational Health and Safety (OHS), environmentally sustainable work practices, electives

Jobs: farm/dairy hand, shearer, livestock agent, merchandise sales

### Certificate III/IV

Qualification in Agriculture, Horticulture (including parks and gardens), Production Horticulture, Conservation and Land Management

Completed as coursework, online, workplace traineeship or recognition for prior learning (RPL)

Subjects include: OHS, environmentally sustainable work practices, electives

Jobs: farm/dairy/orchard/nursery hand, technical officer, leading farm hand, supervisor, wool classer

### Diploma/Advanced Diploma

### Bachelor of Agribusiness

### Bachelor of Science in Agriculture

3-5 years study, full-time at university (some external study options).

Subject areas include: animal, plant and soil science, economics, biotechnology and genetics, horticulture, sustainability, crops and livestock production and management

Jobs: advisor, agronomist, biochemist, consultant, entomologist, forensics, geneticist, microbiologist, animal nutritionist, research scientist, food scientist

### Bachelor of Science in Applied Sciences

3-4 years full-time study at university (some external study options)

Subject areas include: animal science, biological sciences, biotechnology, environmental science, marine science, molecular biology, veterinary science

Jobs: advisor, biologist, ecologist, forester, natural resource manager, research scientist, zoologist
