Mottram Street, Manjimup



What is happening?

Water Corporation will soon begin work to replace the roof of the existing 9,000KL water tank located off Mottram Street in Manjimup. See map attached.

This will improve the reliability of the drinking water service in Manjimup.

To allow us to work on the 9,000KL water tank, a temporary tank and pipework will also be installed. Authorised contractor, V&D Engineering, will carry out this temporary work on our behalf. The contractor to carry out the 9,000KL tank re-roof work will be confirmed in the coming months.

All construction will take place within Water Corporation property only.

When is this work happening?

Work to install the temporary pipework and tank will take place from **early April to early May 2022**. Work will be completed **Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturdays, as required**. We will notify you at least 48 hours in advance of any work taking place outside of these hours.

Work to replace the 9,000KL water tank roof will take place between July and October 2022, we will update you in the coming months regarding the timing and impact of this work.

What impact will this work have?

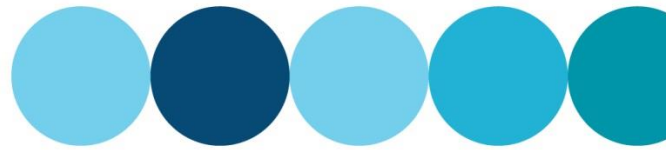
You may notice a small increase in noise, dust and vibration during the construction of the temporary pipeline and tank works. When moving equipment onto the site, there will be an increase in traffic, including heavy vehicles. Construction vehicles will access the site from Marri Road to avoid the cemetery.
